Ensemble Breaks Crayons to Computers ‘Push for Pencils’ Campaign Donation Record for Second Year in a Row

Ensemble Donates \$70,759 Worth of School Supplies

Mason, OH (September 26, 2019) – For the second year in a row, Ensemble has broken all records for the Crayons to Computers ‘Push for Pencils’ Campaign. Ensemble donated 52% more items than the second largest donation, collecting a total of 18,606 school supply items for the non-profit.
